

FRAME SETS



CAUTION

This is a two-person job—one person should hold and adjust the template while the other secures the template.

When working on stairs or high walls, use extreme caution. Secure ladders properly and avoid overreaching.

Step 1—Prepare the Template

1. Unfold the paper template and identify the frame outlines, nail markers and leveling guides.

Step 2—Position and Align the Template

1. If your template consists of two sheets, start by aligning them properly. Match up the top and bottom layouts so the outlines and leveling markers connect seamlessly. Use tape to connect them.
2. Hold the template against the wall in the desired location. Use the leveling markers on the template to ensure it is straight.
3. Secure the template to the wall with painter's tape, making sure it is smooth and fully adhered.

Step 3—Mark Hanging Points

1. Locate the hardware markers on the template, which indicate where to place your hanging hardware.
2. Using the hardware for each frame type, place into wall at each marker location.
3. Once all nails or screws are placed, carefully remove the template from the wall.

Step 4—Hang Your Frames

1. Hang each frame according to the size and position outlined on the template.
2. Double-check alignment with a level, making any necessary adjustments.
