- Stud finder (if mounting on a stud)


Installation Instructions


- Decide where you want to hang the shelf. Use your level and pencil to mark the desired location with a horizontal line on the wall. If you are mounting the shelf into wall studs, use a stud finder to mark the stud locations. Studs provide more strength than drywall, but both are appropriate. Do not use drywall anchors if installing into wall studs.
- Measure the distance between the keyhole slots on the back of the shelf. Then, measure the distance between the keyholes and the edge of the shelf. Use these measurements to mark the positions for the attachment points on the wall.

Note: For each keyhole slot, you'll need to mark three points:

- The location of the top of the keyhole slot
- The location of the bottom of the keyhole slot
- The location of the middle of the keyhole slot

Use your level to ensure the points are level with each other.





- 3 Drill pilot holes into your wall (on the center keyhole mark), gently screw in the wall anchors (if applicable) and then screw in the screws.
- Slide the shelf down onto the screw heads so the screws catch the narrower part of the keyhole slots. This will hold the shelf securely in place. Check that the shelf is level and adjust as needed.
