

Phillips screwdriver




- A. Mirror

- E. Mounting screws x4
- F. Drywall anchors x4
- G. 3/32" Allen wrench
- H. Mounting template



SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS:


Alternative hardware may be required when mounting to a surface other than drywall. or a wall stud. Consult a professional if you have any questions regarding proper installation. All mounting holes must be used for safe installation.

Choose your installation location. Remove the mirror from the wall and use the mounting template, level and a pencil to mark your anchor points. Remove the mounting template after making the marks.

Use a 3/16" drill bit and a power drill to drill a pilot hole at the four installation point marks. Then use a Phillips screwdriver to drive the drywall anchors into the wall until they are flush with the wall surface. Use care not to drive the anchors in past the surface of the drywall.





Mount the wall plates. Make sure the wall plate's set screw heads face down. Use a Phillips screwdriver to drive the mounting screws into the anchors. Once the plates are secured to the wall, attach the cover plate.

Attach the left and right arms to the sides of the mirror, so the set screw holes face down. Tighten the set screws with the included Allen wrench.



Place mirror onto the wall plates. Make sure the set screw holes on the arms face down and align with the set screw holes on the mounting plates. Tighten the set screws using the included Allen wrench.
